



- 1. Perfectionist** – Goody two shoes. Follows the rules. Strong sense of right and wrong. Can be hypercritical, especially of friends and family. Wants to make the world a better place eg. Hermione Granger and Percy Weasley (*Harry Potter*).
- 2. Helper** – Just wants to be loved. Always looking after you. Buys you presents and gives you lots of advice. eg. Sam Gamgee (*LOTR*), Peeta Mellark (*The Hunger Games*).
- 3. Achiever** – A-grade student. Top athlete. Has to be the best. They want to win! Can be charming. Worried about how they look and what people think of them. eg. Gaston (*Beauty and the Beast*), Draco Malfoy (*Harry Potter*).
- 4. Individualist** – Convinced they are special and different from everyone else. Sees beauty in everything. Dramatic, tormented, and very creative. Afraid of being ordinary. eg. Belle (*Beauty and the Beast*), Anne of Green Gables.
- 5. Investigator** – Super smart. Knows everything, but can be a bit robotic. Mad professor. Happiest when they are alone. eg. Sherlock Holmes, Haymitch Abernathy (*The Hunger Games*), Severus Snape (*Harry Potter*).
- 6. Loyalist** – Steady and sensible. Courageous. Prone to anxiety. Likes to be surrounded by loyal friends. Will always be there for you, no matter what. Sometimes rebels against authority and takes risks. eg. Bilbo Baggins (*LOTR*).
- 7. Enthusiast** – So much fun! Big, charismatic energy. Always up for a new adventure. Enthusiastic about everything. Can't stay still. Spontaneous and optimistic. eg. Peter Pan, Pippin Took (*LOTR*), Fred and George Weasley (*Harry Potter*).
- 8. Challenger** – Dominating and self-confident. Don't mess with this person. Quick to anger. Loves to argue. Wants revenge. Can be protective of family and friends. Fears being harmed and controlled by others. eg. Erik/Magneto (*X-Men*), Queen of Hearts (*Alice in Wonderland*), President Coin (*The Hunger Games*).
- 9. Peacemaker** – Easygoing. Hates conflict. Always agrees with you. Wants everyone to be happy. Fears loss and separation. Can explode with anger if pushed too far. eg. Dorothy (*The Wizard of Oz*), Prim (*The Hunger Games*).
